CANCELLATIONS

Refunds will NOT be given for last minute cancellations or no shows. No refunds will be given for accidents, weather or health. The Festival will go on rain or shine.

SET-UP

Set up begins on FRIDAY AUGUST 22 at 8:00am- 4:00pm. No breakdowns before 4:00 pm on Sunday August 24th. Your space will have a exhibitor number that corresponds with the Festival booklet. In order to create uniformity, artists and artisans are asked to use black table coverings. Tents must be weighted down. It is recommended that tents be lowered on Saturday evening in case of wind or rain. There WILL be security on the grounds on Saturday night.

Booth sitters will be available during the Festival. See our volunteers at the Information booth.

Easy unloading and loading. If you have a space in the Hall there are 2 doors in the back for easy access.
